

# Rainbow Bug Printable

## What you need

- Printable
- Cereal or markers
- White school glue (optional)
- Scissors (optional)

## What to do

1. Print out printable
2. Have your child place cereal (i.e. Cheerios, Gorilla Munch or similar) on white spots.
3. If you're not planning on reusing the paper, use glue to secure cereal to each spot.
4. If you'd like to omit the cereal, use markers to colour in the spots.
5. To make the activity more difficult for older children, cut out the bugs and have the child re-arrange them in the proper order of the colours of the rainbow.

- One-to-one ratio (needed for counting and early numeracy)
- Counting
- Number recognition
- Colour recognition
- Colours of the rainbow
